The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.107 dated 27.06.2016 registered under Sections 326, 307, 323/34 IPC at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order dated 29.11.2016, the trial Court granted bail to accused Raghu @ Raghubir Singh, who was arrested on 29.06.2016. The allegations against him were that he kept holding Narinder Singh while the petitioner had given the blow by means of a *Daah* on the head, that is stated to be an attempt to murder.

Learned State counsel submits that no other case of similar nature is reported against the petitioner.

The petitioner is behind the bars since 29.06.2016. Investigation is complete, challan has been presented and even charges have been framed. The trial as such would take time to conclude.

Without making any observation on merits and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and further the fact that the trial will take its own time, he is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-7431 of 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not tamper or influence the prosecution witness(es). The complainant shall be examined within three months from today.
- (iv) In case of violation of the above condition, the liberty is reserved to apply for cancellation of bail.
