Petitioner-Azad, has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.215, dated 28.06.2016, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon, under Section 379 of Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR in the present case has been registered on the application of Raja Ram, wherein he stated that on the intervening night of 25/26.06.2016, he parked his JCB machine bearing registration No.HR-55U-6578, at Laxmi Traders, Tauru Road, Fajalpur and the same was stolen. As per allegation, the main accused, who has stolen the vehicle on the asking of the present petitioner and another co-accused, has sold the same to them for Rs.5,00,000/- on credit basis and the present petitioner and Rashid have further sold the same to some unknown persons

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
