RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 435 dated 03.12.2016, under Sections 398, 307, 401, 420, 467, 468 and 471 I.P.C. and under Sections 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Butana, District Karnal.

Allegations are that the petitioner, along with others,

was involved in looting of people by use of illegal weapons. On the basis of secret information, the FIR was registered and a police party, on receipt of information, proceeded towards the place, where the petitioner, along with others, was present. The raiding party was specifically directed to start the vehicle only after receipt of signal from the person. On receipt of signal of torch light to stop the vehicle, the driver of the vehicle applied brakes, then three young boys with their weapons asked to stop the vehicle. The police officer, along with his colleagues, alighted from the vehicle, then one of the accused started firing at the police party. The police party narrowly escaped by hiding themselves by the side of the vehicle. One of the assailants succeeded in fleeing from the spot and two assailants were arrested. One of them was found to be Rinku and the second accused disclosed his name as Darshan Singh, i.e. the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from A.S.I. Raj Kumar submitted that the recoveries of car and country made pistol have been effected from the petitioner. The petitioner is also involved in one more case.

Taking into consideration the allegations made against the petitioner and others and the stage of the case,

when even evidence has not started, I am not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner at this stage.

Dismissed.
