Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.68 dated 2.5.2016 registered under Sections 436/ 427/ 323/ 324/ 34 IPC and Section 3 /4 of Explosive Substances Act at Police Station C Division, Police Commissionerate District Amritsar.

On 25.4.2017, following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Ms. Pushpinder Kaur, Advocate, appears on behalf of the complainant.

In response to order dated 05.04.2017, learned State counsel on instructions from A.S.I. Karamvir Singh submits that according to the police, there is no compromise effected between the parties.

Let a copy of the compromise be handed over to the Investigating Officer during course of the day.

Adjourned to 23.05.2017.

Let the factum of compromise be ascertained by the Investigating Officer by the adjourned date.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parmajit Singh, has submitted that the factum of compromise has been ascertained by the Investigating Officer and the same is found to be true.

Since the factum of compromise has been established, therefore, without commenting upon merits of the case, I am of the view that the case of the petitioner can be considered for grant of regular bail .

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
