The present revision petition by Rakesh Kumar is directed against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 18.12.2014 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Pathankot, whereby he was convicted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act (hereinafter referred to as, 'the Act') and was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of two years and to pay a fine of Rs.2,000/- and in default of payment of the fine to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of thirty days.

2. The petitioner preferred first appeal against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 18.12.2014 before Sessions Judge, Pathankot, but his appeal was dismissed by first appellate Court vide judgment dated 04.07.2015. Feeling aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the instant revision petition.

3. Today, the matter was taken up in the National Lok Adalat and the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement. Respondent-Karan Singh,

who is present in person, has stated in his statement as under:

“I have received the entire payment. The matter has already been settled between the parties. I have no objection if the present petition is disposed of accordingly.”

4. In view of the above, this petition stands allowed and the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 18.12.2014 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Pathankot and the judgment dated 04.07.2015 of Sessions Judge, Pathankot are set aside.
