By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No.925 dated 23.10.2015, registered under Sections 147, 148, 307, 323 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Civil Lines Hisar, Distt. Hisar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the version of the complainant to the extent that the co-accused, namely, Pawan and Arjun had thrown chilly powder in the eyes of the complainant party, is doubtful in the absence of any report of the ophthalmologist. He further states that only a simple injury on non-vital part is attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in other 8 FIRs, however, in three out of them, he stands acquitted, whereas in the remaining

FIRs he is on bail. Co-accused, Bhag Singh @ Bhagu was admitted to bail by this Court on 22.02.2017.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner gave the spade injury to injured, Jyoti and recovery of knife was effected from him.

Heard.

Considering the above and the fact that co-accused, Bhag Singh @ Bhagu has been admitted to bail by this Court, therefore, no purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
