This is a petition under Section 439 CrPC for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.60 dated 24.2.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 188, 436, 307, 121 IPC and Section 8-B of National Highway Act, 1956 registered at Police Station Murthal, Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the challan has been presented in this case and the petitioner is in custody since 1.3.2016 and another co-accused, namely, Jitender, in the same FIR has filed CRM-M-21274 of 2016 which was allowed vide order dated 21.7.2006.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kuldeep Singh, has accepted the custody period of the petitioner and also accepted the release of co-accused, namely, Jitender.

Keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner and also the fact that the co-accused, namely, Jitender has

already been released on bail and without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of bail.

In view of the above, I am inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. Hence the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-759 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
