On 06.01.2017, following order was passed:-

“The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.6 dated 17.12.2016 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120- B and 201 IPC, Police Station NRI, District Hoshiarpur.

As per the allegations in the FIR, lodged on the complaint of one Amarjeet Singh, who is an NRI, some persons had defrauded him by making duplicate documents and securing loan against his property.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner contends that neither the petitioner has been named in the FIR, nor he is a beneficiary. He further contends that the petitioner is not a witness to any agreement to sell the land or has any role in the alleged

transaction.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner Arjinder Singh shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer, subject to the condition provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is also directed to join the investigation and cooperate with the Investigating Agency, as and when required.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in pursuance of aforesaid order, petitioner has already joined the investigation.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh and further stated that the petitioner is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid, order dated 06.01.2017 is hereby made absolute.
