Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conclude the investigation in case FIR No.140 dated 30.11.2015, under Sections 307/323/341/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Notice of motion was issued in the case on 07.03.2017 and a status report with regard to stage of investigation in the FIR in question was sought.

Learned State counsel has filed in Court today a status report by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Fazilka, District Fazilka and the same is taken on record. Copy has been furnished to counsel for the petitioner.

The stand taken in the status report is that investigation in the matter already stands concluded and the allegations contained in the FIR

have been found to be false and concocted. It has further been stated that

the investigating agency is in the process of submitting a cancellation report in the competent Court.

In the light of such categorical stand taken on behalf of the State, no further directions are required to be passed in the matter.

Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

Needless to observe that in the eventuality of cancellation report being submitted, it would always be open for the petitioner to avail of his remedies in accordance with law.
