Petitioners seek grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.113 dated 05.05.2016, registered under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has brought to the notice of the Court that co-accused Simranjit Singh has already been granted bail by this Court on 28.02.2017 in CRM-M No.3535 of 2017. Similarly, Pawan Kumar @ Tamba also filed CRM-M No.6866 of 2017 which was allowed on 09.03.2017 and the case of the petitioners is covered by the aforesaid orders.

Learned State counsel though opposed the prayer of the petitioners on the ground that in the statements of Sunny and Deepu recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C, they have

named the petitioners and stated that the petitioners have followed the complainant party on motorcycle and were also involved in firing shots.

Since no specific attribution has been made in the FIR, nor in the statements under Section 161 Cr.P.C, therefore, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioners on parity with co-accused Simranjit Singh and Pawan Kumar @ Tamba.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, it will be just and expedient to grant benefit of regular bail to the petitioners. Let the petitioners be enlarged on regular bail, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
