A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The victim suffered the following injuries, as stated in the impugned order made by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana:-

“... Three injuries were reported on his person on spinal and paraspinal dorsolumbar area. A transverse fracture was also reported on L4 & L5 vertebrae in C.T. Scan of the abdomen of the complainant. The copy of bail order dated 23.2.2017 passed by the court of Shri Sandeep Kumar Singla, in bail application relating to FIR No.1 of 2.1.2017, PS Basti Jodhewal, Ludhiana against the applicant produced on record by the counsel for the applicant shows that he remained in jail at Moga from 30.12.2016 to 3.1.2017, whereas the present FIR is dated 14.12.2016 i.e. Prior to his period in jail. The applicant is the main accused in the FIR having inflicted injury

to the complainant at his vital part of the body i.e. Spinal area due to which his custodial investigation appears to be necessary for recovery of the weapon of offence. ...”

Learned Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the fact about receipt of the earnest money as pointed out by learned counsel for the complainant. There is no dispute that the suit has also been filed by the complainant. The petitioner having pocketed huge earnest money, was not at all justified in causing injuries on the vital parts of the body of the complainant, including spinal area merely because he demanded back his money. In that view of the matter, the prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

Dismissed.
