This is a petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.08 dated 12.02.2016, under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala. Petitioner was arrested 22.04.2016 and is in jail since then.

Admittedly, the challan has been filed. Perusal of the report shows that the accused who was caught on the spot along with the contraband, was arrested and it is on his disclosure statement, the petitioner was arrested, in respect of the contraband, i.e. 14 intoxicant vile and 120 intoxicant tablets. No other case is reported against him.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned, subject to

his filing an undertaking on affidavit not to indulge in the similar or any other kind of offence in future, within a period of 2 weeks from today. The petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
