Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition reserving his right to raise the plea about taking adverse inference for not examining the witnesses by the prosecution or in defence, before the trial Court at the time of final arguments.

Law permits that accused can always raise a legally admissible plea/argument available to him at the time of final arguments, as such, no liberty as sought by learned counsel for the petitioner requires to be permitted while allowing the petitioner to withdraw this petition.
