The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 9 dated 03.02.2017 registered under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 188 IPC at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

On 08.03.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was holding the licence for revolver and the same stands deposited with the Deputy Commissioner for adding one more weapon. Therefore, the petitioner could not deposit the weapon held by him. He further contends that neither the weapon was used by the petitioner nor he was arrested from the spot.

Notice of motion for 26.04.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 08.03.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 08.03.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
