On 06.03.2017, following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in respect of occurrence dated 02.02.2017, FIR in question came to be registered on 04.02.2017 in which only simple injuries have been attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 26.04.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 11.03.2017 and in the event

of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh submitted that pursuant to aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required in further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 06.03.2017 is hereby made absolute.
