Petitioner-Gurbir Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case DDR No.22 dated 10.07.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 307 IPC added later on vide DDR No.24 dated 12.09.2016, registered as cross-version of FIR No.52 dated 10.07.2016, under Sections 307, 325, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the cross-version has been got recorded by Pargat Singh. The present petitioner has been stated to be armed with *gandasi* and gave its blow on the head of complainant from

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the reverse side and the said injury has been declared as dangerous to life. The other injuries by the present petitioner alongwith co-accused to Talwinder and Harvinder, sons of the complainant, have also been attributed.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
