Petitioner-Tushar Suneja has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.161 dated 26.04.2016, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad, under Sections 120-B, 34, 384, 506 and 507 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per FIR, the complainant alleged that the present petitioner gave threat to him to remain away from the cases/matrimonial dispute etc.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 10.03.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 10.03.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
