The present petition directs challenge against the judgments passed by the Court below whereby Waryam Chand @ Jag Lal and others accused in FIR No. 199 dated 28.5.2008 under Sections 323, 498-A read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station, Sadar Fazilka were acquitted by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Fazilka vide judgment dated 10.9.2012 and appeal preferred by the petitioner against acquittal did not find favour with the Additional Sessions Judge, Fazilka.

I have gone through the judgments passed by the courts below but do not find any patent error much less illegality in the consistent findings recorded by the courts below warranting intervention in exercise of limited revisional jurisdiction when the case is examined in the light of principles culled out by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in **Ganpat vs. State of Haryana (2010) 12 SCC 450**. It would be pertinent to mention that even counsel for the petitioner has failed to point out that the courts below have failed to take into consideration any evidence which has a material bearing on decision of the case qua culpability of the respondents. In view of the above, the petition sans merit and deserves to be rejected.

For the foregoing reasons, the petition fails and is accordingly dismissed.
