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**JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.**

The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.157 dated 29.10.2016 registered under Sections 323, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

On 7.3.2017, while issuing notice of motion and granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Notice of motion for 21.03.2017.

To be heard along with CRM-M-42509 of 2016.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions mentioned below, as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C :-

- i. a condition that the person shall make himself available for interrogation by Police Officer as and when required;
- ii. a condition that the person shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- iii. a condition that the person shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;
- iv. such other condition as may be imposed under sub section (3) of Section 437, as if the bail were granted under that section.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, informs that the petitioner has joined investigation in compliance of the order dated 7.3.2017 and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 7.3.2017, vide which the petitioner was granted interim

anticipatory bail is made absolute subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
