passed.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by obligating respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation made by the petitioner. In case, any cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then suitable directions can be issued to respondent No.3 to act in accordance with law.

If life and personal liberty of the petitioner are found to be threatened at the hands of some wrong doers, then appropriate action be taken in accordance with law.
