The matter is stated to be still under investigation. Complainant in fact is Axis Bank. Allegations against the present petitioner are with regard to having forged and fabricated Aadhar Cards for the imposter including Deepak Arora, who was neighbor of the petitioner and on the strength of such forged documents having defrauded the bank of a heavy sum of Rs.70 lacs.

In view of the fact that the matter is still at the stage of investigation, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner benefit of regular bail in case FIR No.183 dated 01.10.2016 under sections 408, 419, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 477-A, 120-B, 201 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Dakha, District Ludhiana, at this stage.

Petition is dismissed.
