As recorded in the order dated 14.03.2017, the petitioner was admitted to interim bail primarily on the ground that though he was a proclaimed offender, however the proceedings in which he was required to appear before the trial Court, have concluded, with eight of his co-accused having been acquitted.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Faily Singh, submits that the petitioner, after the interim bail granted by this Court on 14.03.2017, has been regularly appearing before the trial Court.

Consequently, the order dated 14.03.2017 is made absolute on the same bail bonds and surety bonds already furnished by the petitioner, subject to his continuing to appear before the trial Court.
