The present petition has been filed under Section 438
the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 180 dated
30.09.2016 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police
Station Model Town, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

On 08.03.2017 this Court had passed the following
order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the matter stands amicably
settled between the parties and the petitioners have paid the
entire amount.

Notice of motion for 21.03.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioners by the
Arresting Officer, they shall be released on interim bail
subject to the following conditions:-

1.That they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2.That they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

3.That they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 08.03.2017, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant admits the factum of compromise.

In view of above, the order dated 08.03.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioners to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
