In the present case, the petitioner is stated to have been in custody since 30.11.2015 as regards the FIR in question in the present petition, though otherwise he is in custody since 18.11.2015, in connection with another FIR having been registered against him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that out of 15 witnesses only 8 have been examined.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, as also the nature of the offence in question, without making any comment on the merits of the case against the petitioner, with the trial not likely to conclude in the near future, he is ordered to be admitted to bail in the present FIR, on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
