In cross case Rapat/DDR No.22 dated 30.09.2016, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), in FIR No.151 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 302, 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 08.03.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
