Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhmander Singh, Police Station, Mehna District Moga states that as as a result of inquiry conducted by DSP Dharamkot, petitioner-Ravinder Singh @ Binda has been found to be innocent, as such, he is not required to be arrested in this case. He further states that if at any stage of investigation, the petitioner is required to be arrested, then the police would give seven days advance notice to enable him to avail of his remedy of seeking pre-arrest

bail, if so advised.

It being so, no cause of action survives to the petitioner and
petition for pre-arrest bail is dismissed as infructuous.
