This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.03 dated 08.01.2017 under sections 307, 436, 427, 323, 148, 149 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR has been registered on the statement of one Deepak Agnihotri, respondent no.2.

Allegations are that the present petitioners had assaulted the complainant on his arms with a baseball bat.

It has gone uncontroverted that the injuries attributed to the petitioners, otherwise, have been opined to be simple in nature.

Petitioners were arrested on 20.1.2017 and 18.1.2017 respectively.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh would submit that the complainant has since filed an affidavit as regards a compromise having been entered into.

Deepak Agnihotri son of Sh. Madan Lal is present in person and is duly identified by the I.O. He also submits that he has compromised the matter with the accused party.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.

Petition disposed of.
