The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.56 dated 22.05.2016, under Sections 341, 323, 506, 336 & 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of no injury and the allegations are that the petitioner No.1 had fired in the air and petitioner No.2 is stated to have beaten up the complainant.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 08.03.2017, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and in the event of their arrest, they were directed to be released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, states that in terms of the previous orders of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the orders dated 08.03.2017 and 10.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
