Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Mukhtiar Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.178 dated 28.10.2016 at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar Rural under Sections 326/323/325/324/506/148/149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in consequence of the orders of interim bail dated 08.03.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.03.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
