INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Bakhtaur Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.53 dated 21.04.2015, registered at Police Station Urban Estate Patiala, District Patiala, under Sections 302, 365, 201, 420 and 489 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that it is a double murder case and

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FIR was got recorded by Jasvir Singh. The present petitioner is the main accused in this case. Though, it was a blind murder case, but during the course of investigation, it was found that the present petitioner was driver of Jaspal Kaur (since deceased). There are allegations that after committing the murder of Jaspal Kaur, the present petitioner also committed the murder of her son. As per the prosecution version, mobile phone as well car of the deceased have been recovered from the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
