INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Sonu @ Sawan has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.667 dated 20.10.2016, registered at Police Station Samalkha, Panipat, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, FIR, in the present case, was got registered by complainant-Mukesh Kumar. As per the allegations, ₹10 lakhs were taken by petitioner-Sonu @ Sawan and one Dheeraj Midha for sending the complainant to Dubai and thereby they cheated the complainant.

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Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
