Pursuant to the order dated 28.3.2017, a reply by way of an affidavit of Shri Madan Lal, Deputy Superintendent of Police-I, Yamuna Nagar, has been filed, which is taken on record, stating that as per the investigation carried out so far, none of the firms to which loans are stated to have been given by the petitioners, in connivance with others, are actually in existence.
