This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.57 dated 1.3.2016 under section 379-A I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Ambala City, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Prosecution version is that the petitioners while riding a motorcycle had allegedly snatched the purse of the complainant's mother.

Petitioners are shown to be in custody in the present case since 17.12.2016 and 18.12.2016 respectively.

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that they had been implicated on a previous occasion in FIR No.527 dated 13.12.2016 on similar allegations i.e. of having snatched the purse of a police official and it is during the course of investigation of such FIR that the present petitioners are sought to be implicated in the present case on the disclosure statement of Raj Kumar.

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioners have already been granted benefit of bail in FIR No.527 dated 13.12.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan stands presented and even charges have been framed. Trial is stated to be at the initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ambala.

Petition disposed of.
