This common order shall dispose of the aforesaid two petitions, as similar question of facts and law involved in both the petitions.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that all the material witnesses have turned hostile. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the State, upon going through the copy of the depositions of the

witnesses. It is unfortunate that the material witnesses have turned hostile. The reason may be the absence of witness protection policy, which has yet not come in existence.

Be that as it may, since witnesses have turned hostile and there is no alternative except to grant bail.

The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
