Report from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court received. Parties have arrived at settlement. Settlement agreement has been submitted with the report. In view of the settlement/compromise between the parties, learned counsel for the complainant states that he has no objection if the judgments of both the Courts below are set aside and the petitioner be acquitted of the notice of accusation served upon him.

In view of the matter, the present petition is allowed. Judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 26.9.2014, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar convicting and sentencing the petitioner under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and the judgment dated 4.7.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, affirming the said judgment are hereby set aside and the petitioner stands acquitted of the notice of accusation served upon him. Bail bonds are surety bonds stand discharged.
