REKHA MITTAL, J.

The present petition directs challenge against consistent findings recorded by the Courts below whereby the respondent has been acquitted of the offence punishable under Sections 354 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC') by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Mahendergarh vide judgment dated 04.08.2012 and the appeal preferred by the State through Priyanka Devi – complainant did not find favour with the Additional Sessions Judge, Narnaul and as a result findings recorded by the trial Court were affirmed.

I have gone through the judgments passed by the Courts below but do not find any error much less patent illegality in the findings constituting a substantial and compelling reason for this Court to differ with the findings recorded by the Courts below. In this view of the matter, the petition fails and is accordingly dismissed.
