Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in FIR No. 22, dated 18.02.2017, registered under Section 379-A IPC, at Police Station Rewari, District GRP Ambala Cantt.

Seeking regular bail for the petitioner, learned counsel submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case; there is no other criminal case pending against her; she is a widow with a four years' old child to look after; she is no longer needed for investigation purposes as the challan has already been filed; she is in custody since 18.02.2017 and since the charges have not been framed, the trial is likely to take long time to conclude.

Learned State counsel opposes the grant of bail but does not dispute that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner who is a widow; she is having a four years' old child; that the challan has already been filed in the present case and that the trial is not likely to conclude in the near future.

After considering the rival submissions and without commenting on the merits of the matter, I am of the view that the petitioner deserves to be admitted to regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Rewari.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.

During the period that the bail is granted to the petitioner, if she is found indulging in any criminal/illegal activity or misusing the concession of bail granted by this Court, it would be open to the State to move an appropriate application before the competent Court/this Court for cancellation of the bail granted to the petitioner.
