Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 30.9.2016 under Sections 420/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 27.3.2017 of this Court, whereby the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre, parties have joined the mediation proceedings and a settlement/agreement dated 22.5.2017 has been arrived at between the parties. As per the agreement/settlement, parties have agreed to resolve their present dispute amicably. They have incorporated the terms

and conditions of the said agreement/settlement broadly in para 7 of the agreement/settlement deed.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that in view of the compromise before the mediator, he has no objection in case the order dated 27.3.2017 is made absolute.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, whereby the petitioner is required to pay the outstanding amount on or before 26.3.2020, the interim order dated 27.3.2017 is made absolute.
