The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.181 dated 01.10.2016 for the offence under Sections 354, 354 A, 509, 34, 323, 341 IPC, registered at P.S.Model Town, District Ludhiana.

Petitioner is in custody since 02.01.2017.

As per FIR, the allegation against the petitioner is that Varinder Singh alias Raju alongwith three/four unknown persons were standing and stopped the Activa/Scooter of the prosecutrix. When the complainant tried to run away by leaving her Activa/Scooter, then Varinder Singh caught her and slapped her and also abused her. Varinder Singh @ Raju and other boys attempted to take her forcibly in his Maruti Car and when she raised alarm all the assailants run away. The petitioner is not named in the FIR and there is no allegation against him that he had molested the complainant.

Learned State counsel submits that charges have been framed and no custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required further.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is not likely to mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Ludhiana.
