Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.56 dated 23.09.2016 registered under Sections 454, 380 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur, on the basis of compromise (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 09.03.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 20.03.2017 for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla and got recorded their statements. Report

from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide covering letter

No.384 dated 23.03.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Sangrur vide Endorsement No.1865/EB dated 24.03.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, a voluntary compromise has been effected in between the complainant and accused persons without any coercion or pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.56, is quashed qua the petitioners.
