ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.70 dated 03.09.2016 under Sections 452/427/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioners in the FIR are that they had trespassed into the house of complainant. No injury is alleged to have been caused to any of the party in the incident. The petitioners and the complainant are residents of same village and the matter has now been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 09.03.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for

recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malout, has sent his report dated 19.04.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The parties are residents of same village and the matter has been compromised. They want to live in peace and harmony.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.70 dated 03.09.2016 under Sections 452/427/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner only.
