Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.080 dated 11.06.2016 under Sections 21/22/27/27-A/29 NDPS Act and Sections 25/27 Arms Act registered at Police Station C-Division, District Amritsar.

As per the FIR, 500 grams of Heroin, currency of Rs.22,000/- and one electronic weighing machine were recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner, which suggests that another case i.e. FIR No.50/15 under

Section 22 NDPS Act and Section 61 Excise Act, P.S. C Division, Amritsar has been registered against the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner was found in possession of 500 grams of Heroin, currency of Rs.22,000/- and one electronic weighing machine and another case under the NDPS Act is pending against him, this Court does not find any ground to release him on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
