Counsel for the petitioner would state that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted vide order dated 10.3.2017 and is ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Naib Singh, concedes to the factum of joining investigation and further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

(i) He shall join the investigation as and when required by

the Investigating Officer.

(ii)He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and

(iii)He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
