ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.216 dated 30.09.2006, under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the matter has been compromised by the parties and it would be in the interest of justice, if the aforementioned petition is allowed and the consequential proceedings are quashed on the basis thereof. Learned counsel further states that the injured has fully recovered and the incident was outcome of misunderstanding between the parties.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 13.01.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial

Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Ludhiana, dated 22.08.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of misunderstanding, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.216 dated 30.09.2006, under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
