INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Kuldeep Singh and Jagsir Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.68 dated 30.09.2015, registered at Police Station Jourkian, District Mansa, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for brevity, 'IPC')

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that it is a case of version and cross-version and petitioner No.2-Jagsir Singh is also stated to have received injuries. All the offences except under Section 452 of the Indian Penal Code are bailable in nature.

At this stage keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the fact that it is yet to be decided on the basis of evidence by the trial court as to who is the aggressor party, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on anticipatory bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
