JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

This is the third bail application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in FIR No.43 dated 24.03.2016, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, Fazilka.

It is contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner is in custody since 24.03.2016. No independent witness has been joined by the police party.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that allegedly 300 grams of heroin was recovered from the petitioner and the same is a commercial quantity.

Heard.

Considering the facts that the quantity in question is commercial in nature and that there are no fresh circumstances in favour of the petitioner, no case is made out to grant the relief sought.

Dismissed.
