In nutshell, the petitioner was convicted by learned JMFC, Faridkot under Sections 304-A and 427 IPC and sentenced to undergo maximum sentence of rigorous imprisonment for two years. However, the sentence under Section 304-A IPC was reduced to one year in appeal. The petitioner has undergone the said sentence including the remissions. Now

after more than 13 years he has filed the present revision petition impugning the judgments of the learned Courts below. It is claimed that he was a bus driver. I am of the view that the reason mentioned in the application was that the petitioner was working as a driver and could not file the revision is not acceptable. There is no ground to condone the huge delay of more than 13 years in filing the revision petition.

In view of the above, the application for condonation of delay of 5039 days in filing the present revision petition is dismissed.

Consequently, the revision also stands dismissed.
