The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to ensure a free and fair investigation in FIR No. 68 dated 12.06.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station Pasyana, District Patiala.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner himself is the complainant/injured and it is on his complaint that the FIR in question had been registered in relation to an occurrence that took place on 11.06.2016.

An apprehension has been voiced in the petition that the Investigating Officer is hand-in-glove with the accused party and is pressurizing the petitioner to compromise the matter.

Without even going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to move a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala as regards his grievance and apprehension.

In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
