By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 39 dated 01.04.2015, registered under Section 22 of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

On 20.03.2017, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Contends that the authorities were intimidated by the petitioner to produce him in the instant FIR, however, he was not produced. The petitioner was in custody in FIR No.26 dated 20.02.2012. The absence of the petitioner is not willful or intentional.

Notice of motion for 10.05.2017.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a week from today, in that eventuality, he shall be admitted to bail on his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of order dated 20.03.2017, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has furnished bail/surety bonds.

The learned State counsel does not dispute the above said fact.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.03.2017, is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
