Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that on completion of investigation, challan has been presented, charge has been framed and the case is pending for evidence of the prosecution. It is further submitted that as the criminal proceedings have emerged out of marital dispute, the parties may be referred to Mediator to explore possibility of an amicable settlement.

In view of the above, petition stands disposed of but with liberty to the petitioners to make a request to the trial court for referring the parties to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Guhla, if any, or at Kaithal.

Any such request made by the petitioners would be considered by the trial court in right perspective, examine possibility of an amicable settlement and refer the parties for mediation if the court would find that there is an element of matter being settled by way of compromise.
